## EMPLOYMENT INTERVIEW TIPS

**Be prepared at your interview by thinking of answers to these below questions. If you need help with how to answer these types of questions contact WorkOne or KIC-IT (Kids In Crisis Intervention Team).**

1. What is your greatest strength?
2. What is your greatest weakness?
3. How do you handle stress and pressure?
4. How do you evaluate success on the job?
5. Why do you want this job?
6. Why did you leave your last job?
7. Why should we hire you?
8. What are your goals for your future?
9. Tell me a little about yourself?

### Tips for a successful interview!

1. Listen carefully to questions
2. Answer questions as directly as possible
3. Use examples of how your skills and abilities would fit into the job you are interviewing for
4. Be upbeat and use positive statements
5. Check out the company before the interview – check out their website
6. Greet the employee with a firm handshake and make eye contact
7. Dress for success
8. Practice interviewing at WorkOne or KIC-IT
9. Go alone – no children or friends
10. Make frequent eye contact
11. Have confidence
12. Believe in yourself

Remember to say, “**THANK YOU**” at the end of the interview! 😊

### Common Interview Mistakes – What NOT to do!!!

1. Do NOT be late
2. Do NOT show up unprepared
3. Do NOT lie
4. Do NOT ask if there is any reason why you should not be hired
5. Do NOT bring a drink or be chewing gum – do NOT bring anything that could distract you
6. Do NOT ask about salary, benefits and perks (save this for when they offer you the job!)



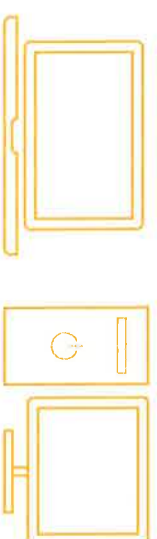
